

Action Plan for implementation of the SVEEP in Medchal-Malkajgiri District.

i) All the EROs of Medchal-Malkajgiri district have been issued instruction to prepare a comprehensive SVEEP Plan for roll out and along with implementation.

ii) SVEEP strategy formulated in consultation with NGOs / CSOs / Youth Organizations / Media Agencies for targeted interventions in these areas and identifies the Polling Stations with lower voters registrations and reasons thereof, Polling Stations with high number of vulnerable/excluded sections and taking necessary action to rectify the defects / omissions.

(iii) In consideration of the fact that registration process and methods are still far from being the friendliest, the EROs / AEROs shall take all steps possible to facilitate registration of voters with least inconvenience to them. The services of E-Seva centres, E-Regn shall be utilized apart from receipt of applications by EROs / AEROs / BLOs and new strategies like drop boxes at educational institutions, premises of big industries, shopping malls / theatres / petrol pumps and provision of Voter Facilitation Centre at public places during the revision period shall be adopted.

(iv) All the EROs / AEROs have been requested to update the details of BLOs (replacement in place of transferred / expired / promoted BLOs) and furnish the same to this office to upload to CEO's website.

(v) Voluntary support extended to the BLOs by involving RWAs (Resident Welfare Associations) and CSOs (Civil Society Organizations) etc to work with BLOs in the role of Booth Level Volunteers. Consultations with the Civil Society Organizations, RWAs shall be motivated in thus regard and seek their cooperation, apart from Booth Level Agents of Political parties. The CSOs / NGOs and RWAs shall be motivated to approach people for mobilization for registration by taking up consultation with them.

(vi) Corporates (public / private industries, Corporate Offices ect) have been requested to ensure registration of their employees.

(vii) Organizing mock registration and mock polling at all educational institutions through EROs / AEROs / BLOs / CSOs etc.

(viii) Making availability of Forms (Form-6, 7, 8 & 8A) at all prominent places like Post Offices, E-Seva Centres, Colleges / Other Educational Institutions, Big Corporate Offices, Designated Centres, Polling Station Locations, etc., in addition to the offices of District Election Officer, ERO / AERO / CSOs.

(ix) Sufficient Forms 6, 7, 8 and 8A will be made available at all educational institutions where the students of 18 years and above age group are studying and the Heads of the institutions be requested to designate one faculty member to get the forms filled in; if the student has become 18 years old as on the qualifying date and liaison with the ERO/AERO Drop boxes at educational institutions along with blank forms shall be arranged and be cleared on regular intervals through EROs / AEROs / BLOs.

(x) Organizing training camps at higher educational institutions / PG Colleges / Degree Colleges / Engineering Colleges / Universities through EROs / AEROS / BLOs to get forms filled in accurately. Identifying one Designated Officer from Revenue Department and one Designated Officer from the Educational Institutions for proper cooperation in getting enrollment of eligible students as voters in all Institutions.

(xi) Organizing special campaigns through local artists in all prominent places / sandy places in habitations for voters' awareness.

(xii) Special attention and facilitation measures have been taken for youth & women in the rural and agency areas.

(xiii) NYKS / NSS / Anganwadi / Self Help Groups should be engaged in rural areas for achieving cent percent registration.
